Dreamweaver Templates

Using the Duke Template

- 1. http://www.duke.edu/~crumley/documents/duke_portfolio.zip download to desktop
- 2. Extract files to new folder
- 3. Create site in DW, specify the new folder as place for files
- 4. Modify the dwt file and/or css file for overall appearance, navigation
- 5. Modify individual pages for content

Using a Different Template

- 1. Download template from http://www.oswd.org to desktop
- 2. Create folder on desktop
- 3. Extract files to new folder, manage as necessary to have index.html loose in folder
- 4. Create site in DW, specify the new folder as place for files
- 5. Modify index and/or css file in Dreamweaver for appearance, navigation
- 6. Insert > Template Objects > Editable Region)
- 7. Ctrl-S to save; DW should automatically save this file as a dwt in Templates folder
- 8. Delete index.html; create new index.html based on new template (see below)

HELPFUL TIPS

- Make changes ONE AT A TIME and view html files in browser: F12
- Edit > Preferences > New Document >
 Default extension: html
- Edit > Preferences > Copy/Paste > (pasting options)
- Save your css outside of Templates folder
- ♦ File names: no caps, spaces or symbols
- use folders for images, documents
- Rename & move files in Dreamweaver to update links
- ♦ Stuck? Try Crayons & newsprint
- Never ever ever use MS Word for web!

Creating New Portfolio Pages

- 1. Right click site to create a new html page (F8 brings up file list)
- 2. Name and save outside the Templates folder
- 3. Modify > Templates > Apply Template to Page > (template name)
- 4. Copy and paste your content into the editable region; Ctrl-S to save
- 5. Open dwt file, make link in menu to new file.
- 6. Save dwt file and choose update; go back to the new page and check it out in a browser(F12)
- 7. Repeat for each new document
- 8. PUT the entire site (will be available at http://www.duke.edu/~username)

Creating a Site in Dreamweaver

- 1. Create a Dreamweaver site
- 2. Name site
- 3. No server technology
- 4. Edit on local machine
- 5. Specify your local folder (the one you just created on the desktop)
- 6. How do you connect: FTP

- 7. Hostname of web server: **godzilla.acpub.duke.edu**
- 8. What folder on the server: public_html
- 9. Your username...
- 10. Your user password...
- 11. Make it secure & test it
- 12. Do not enable check in and check out
