

Using the short clips you recorded to enhance your *portrait* of your character, make a short video to post to Voicethread for comments.

### 1. Connecting to your computer

- Use the USB connector in the camera (be careful - don't break!) and plug in directly to the USB port on the side of the laptop
- Double-click on the Finder icon to see the icon for the Flip camera
- Double-click the Flip camera icon to open
- Go into the DCIM folder and browse to your video clips
- *Note: If you have never used the Flip on this computer before, you will need to run Flipshare. Find the Flip drive on your computer and the Flipshare program. If you do not do this step, iMovie will not recognize your clips in the next step.*



### 2. Getting your clips into iMovie 08

- Find iMovie 08 and open it
- Create a new project in iMovie, giving it a name that makes sense for your assignment
- Go to the window with your Flipcam clips
- Drag each clip over into iMovie
- Save your iMovie project

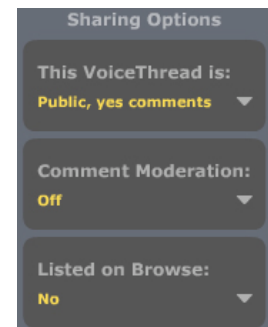


### 3. Edit your movie & export

- Manipulate your clips as desired to set up your movie
- Trim clips as needed and place on timeline
- Export / share to .mp4 format on the laptop, using a filename with no spaces or punctuation (e.g. *french76-lastname*)

### 4. Upload to Voicethread

- Open a Web browser and go to <http://duke.voicethread.com>
- Log in using your netID
- Click on 1. Create, then upload from your computer, using the file you created in step three
- Click on 3. Share, and set to “Public, not listed” (see graphic at right for exact settings)
- Click on “Embed” (under “Share”). In the window that opens, you will see a link (this is the link within that window, not the one that shows up at the top of the page). Click on “Copy this”. This is the link that you will paste into your wiki to share with others. Note that Mozilla Firefox does not allow for pasting within the wiki, so you will have to go through Internet Explorer for this.



### 5. Comment on Voicethreads

- Go into VoiceThread.
- When you are ready to comment, click on the Comment button
- Click on the audio or video comment button

- Record your comment, then click the button again to save or cancel
- If you are using a webcam and it is not showing video, right click (or control-Click on a Mac) the video button to set the camera input to USB.
